PARADE STARTS AT NOON

PARADE

The Children's Wish Parade of Pumpkin Paddlers will begin at NOON from Hants County Exhibition Grounds, Wentworth Road, Windsor - take Exit 5A to the start of the parade. This is the best opportunity to film all the decorated pumpkin boats.

Parade Route

11:00 Parade line-up begins at the Hants County Exhibition Grounds - Exit 5A - Wentworth Road

Noon Parade will leave the Exhibition Grounds, turning right onto Wentworth Road.

The parade will make its way to Gerrish Street. All Personal Vegetable Craft will turn left onto Water Street and head to the Falmouth Side of Lake Pesaquid.

The remainder of the parade will turn right onto Water Street and then right onto King Street. The parade will disperse at Fort Edward and King Street.

PLEASE NOTE:

The Falmouth Bridge will be closed to all westbound traffic (heading to Falmouth) except for the pumpkin boats. The Falmouth Bridge will be open to eastbound traffic (heading towards Windsor) once the parade has concluded. The Falmouth Bridge will remain closed, until opened by the Windsor RCMP. Estimated closure time: 1:00 pm to 2:30 pm

Stannus Street, Windsor, is closed due to Infrastructure Improvements.

Arrive early and be prepared to walk. Bring your lawn chairs or blankets to sit on at the waterfront.

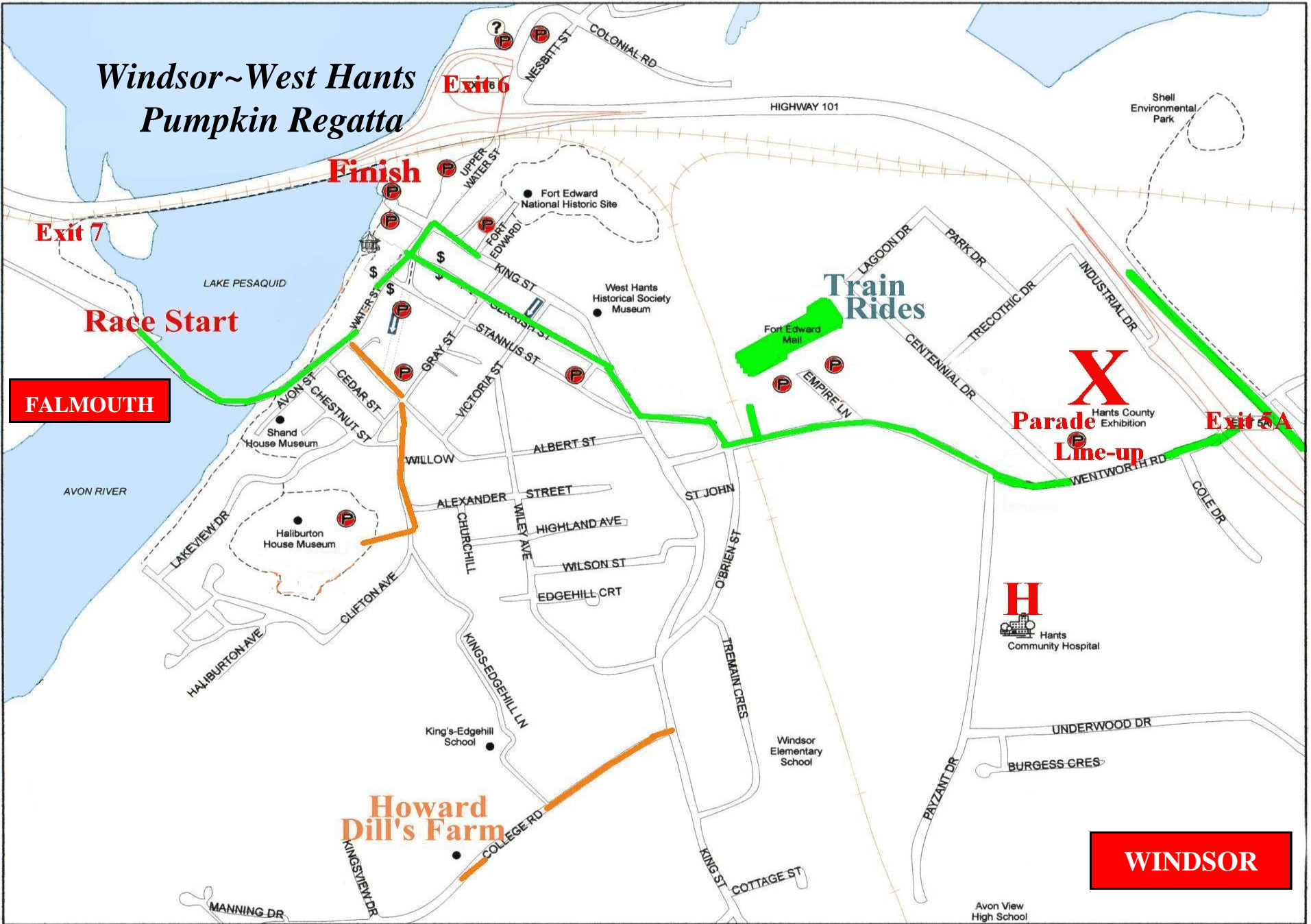

TRAVELLING BY CAR

If you are travelling south from the Halifax International Airport, take Highway 102 to Exit 1 and Highway 101. Take Exit 4 to reach the Rawdon Hills, Exit 5 for Brooklyn and Windsor, Exit 5A and 6 for Windsor, Exit 7 for Falmouth.

Highway 101 runs through West Hants northwest to the Annapolis Valley and south to the Halifax Regional Municipality.
